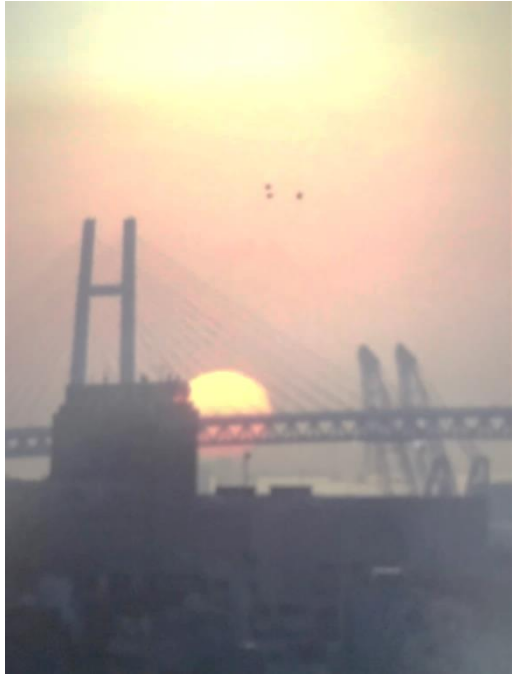
Today, I've read a book called "Jonathan Livingston Seagull" by R. Back and I found some interesting facts as follows;
